The idea of spending another \$770 million on gas turbines, at a time when we are drowning in debt is absolutely ridiculous?

Hydro should be investing in itself and its assets, instead of mothballing a several billion dollar plant to jump into a brand new debt load, which the province can not afford.

Holyrood after having the proper maintenance and boiler cleaning produced 500 megawatts of power last year, with unit 2 online now producing a sound 120 megawatts daily, with better than ever DAFOR ratings. The plant may be 50 years old, but it's service hours are roughly only 23 years per unit.
