## Reference on Rate Mitigation Options and Impacts Relating to the Muskrat Falls Project

## **Notice of Public Hearing**

The Board has been directed by the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador to review and report on rate mitigation options and impacts associated with the costs of the Muskrat Falls Project on electricity rates up to the year 2030, including cost savings and revenue opportunities with respect to the generation, transmission distribution, sales and marketing assets and activities of Nalcor Energy and its subsidiaries. The Board's interim report was submitted to Government on February 15, 2019 and a final report is required by January 31, 2020.

The final reports of the Board's consultants (The Liberty Consulting Group and Synapse Energy Economics) were filed on September 3, 2019. These reports and other information about the review, can be found on the Board's website (<a href="www.pub.nl.ca">www.pub.nl.ca</a>).

A public hearing has been scheduled to start on Thursday, October 3, 2019 at 9:30 a.m. at the Board's offices in St. John's. At the hearing the Board's consultants will present their findings and parties who have standing will have the opportunity to present evidence and ask questions.
