- 5 A. Newfoundland Power does not have any specific information on the potential costs 6 associated with building out infrastructure to allow Level 2 and/or Level 3 public 7 charging stations for electric vehicles in and around its service territory.

Newfoundland Power has internal experience with installing two Level 2 chargers at its head office parking lot. Table 1 shows the costs incurred from this installation.
