The Company's projected staffing levels are outlined in its Labour Forecast, provided as Attachment A in response to Information Request PUB-NP-054. The forecast shows that, in 2019, Newfoundland Power plans to hire 4 Power Line Technician Apprentices, and 4 Information Technology/Customer Service specialists to assist with the Customer Service System replacement project.¹ In 2020, the Company plans to hire 4 Power Line Technician Apprentices, and 2 Information Technology/Customer Service specialists to assist with the Customer Service System replacement project.²
