1	Q.	Please describe the departments responsible for the design and application of the
2		wood pole program.
3		
4	A.	Newfoundland Power does not have a dedicated wood pole program. Inspection and
5		maintenance practices for wood poles are included in the Company's Distribution
6		Inspections and Maintenance Practices and Transmission Inspections and Maintenance
7		<i>Practices</i> . These documents are provided as Attachments A and C in response to
8		Information Request PUB-NP-056.
9		
10		Corporate responsibility for transmission and distribution inspections and maintenance
11		practices resides with the Director of Eastern Region.
12		
13		The design and application of the distribution and transmission inspections and
14		maintenance practices resides with the Supervisor of Transmission Engineering. The
15		Supervisor of Transmission Engineering works closely with the Manager of Regional
16		Engineering for St. John's Region, the Manager of Area Operations for Eastern Region
17		and the Manager of Area Operations for Western Region to implement any necessary
18		revisions to the inspections and maintenance practices.
19		
20		Inspections and maintenance activities are undertaken by Planners in each of
21		Newfoundland Power's three operating regions in accordance with the established
22		practices.
