Q. Please provide the O&M budgets for 2019 to 2023 for Newfoundland Hydro's
 Interconnected Distribution Systems, by Region.

A. Hydro's interconnected distribution system services rural customers located in approximately 180 communities on the South Coast, Northeast Coast and along the Great Northern Peninsula. Hydro's distribution system costs are grouped in the Transmission, Distribution and NL System Operator Division. Hydro records direct distribution costs in their own business units within the division. However, a component of distribution costs would also be included in the Management, Planners, Support & Admin department in the Transmission, Distribution and NL System Operator Division. Please refer to Table 1 for the Transmission, Distribution and NL System Operator Division operating costs including the costs related to the distribution systems:¹
