6	A.	PUB-Nalcor-226, Attachment 1, Table 1 lists the comparison "Trade" wage rates
7		represented by Power Line Technician (Line Worker A) from 2003 to 2022 for the
8		Atlantic Canadian Utilities. Table 2 in the same attachment reflects the wage
9		differential between Hydro and the Atlantic Canadian Utilities (ACU) and
10		Newfoundland Power (NF Power), respectively, from 2003 to 2018. The "Trade"
11		wage difference between Hydro and the ACU has averaged -\$0.47 and has averaged
12		-\$0.96 when compared to NF Power over the same period. Hydro, New Brunswick
13		Power and Nova Scotia Power have expired agreements (beyond 2018) and are in
14		collective bargaining at this time. NF Power and Maritime Electric have recently
15		signed (or ratified) agreements securing wage rates up to 2022.
