Do the capital projects in relation to Bay D'Espoir, including for maintenance and enhanced operation of Bay D'Espoir plant as well as for transmission capacity from Bay D'Espoir, as proposed or projected in Hydro's Capital Plan, as filed in the 2018 Capital Budget Application, take into account the reasonably foreseeable capital additions (excluding the cost of construction and commissioning of a new Bay D'Espoir turbine itself) necessary to accommodate the 154.4 MW of capacity which would be added to the Island Interconnected System by a new turbine?

A. At this time, the Bay d'Espoir Unit 8 study is to estimate this potential generation source that is in Hydro's portfolio of potential generation sources. As there is no intention to commence construction of this project at this time, Hydro has not considered this potential generation source in the current Capital Budget Application, and is not pre-building any infrastructure in relation to this. In addition, no current capital projects would be redundant or adjusted should the potential Bay d'Espoir Unit 8 project be constructed. If and when this project is deemed necessary, Hydro will apply to the Board, and such application will include any and all required capital improvements.
