- 10 (i) The relevant passage is found at page 11, lines 2 - 5 of *2018 Cost of Service*  
11 *Methodology Review Report, November 15, 2018* (Schedule 1 to the Application).

- 13 (ii) The word “basis” is used by Mr. Brockman in the referenced passage in its  
14 ordinary meaning of something that underlies or supports a thing. It reflects Mr.  
15 Brockman’s interpretation of the passage referred to in part (i) above, which  
16 indicated that selection of the Muskrat Falls Project was primarily based on “the  
17 projected fuel cost savings over the long term.”  
18
- 19 (iii) It is not Mr. Brockman’s position that long-term fuel cost savings were the only  
20 reason for proceeding with the Muskrat Falls Project.  
21
- 22 (iv) It is not Mr. Brockman’s position that minimizing revenue requirements over the  
23 lifetime of a generation resource is not one of Hydro’s planning criteria.
