

1 Q. Does Hydro anticipate filing a Supplemental Capital Budget Application or to add expenditures in
2 its Allowance for Unforeseen Items Account following the review of the Reliability and Resource
3 Adequacy Study?

6 A. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) does not anticipate any capital additions resulting
7 from the Reliability and Resource Adequacy Study (“Study”)¹ which would require filing a
8 Supplemental Capital Budget Application. The Allowance for Unforeseen Items Account is an
9 approved annual capital project for emergency work; planned work would not be applied to this
10 account. The Study is the subject of a separate proceeding by the Board of Commissioners of
11 Public Utilities. Results of that proceeding may result in the requirement for incremental
12 planned Capital Budget expenditures in future years.
