

- 1 Q. What does NL Hydro do with excess energy that is no longer needed from the export market?
- 2 a) Is it “dump loaded” at the generation point or at the export point?
- 3 b) Does “dump loading” add a cost of generation/transport that receives no revenue?
- 4 c) How often does NL Hydro dump load excess energy within Labrador? How many kwh of
- 5 unsold power does this represent per year?
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- 8 A. a) Dump loading is not an option available to Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”). As
- 9 noted in Hydro’s response to BKL-NLH-007 of this proceeding, electricity generation and
- 10 consumption are closely matched at all times. Hydro does not generate energy that is excess
- 11 to demand, including demand from export markets.
