Α. Actual purchase prices of vehicles and aerial devices have been lower than budgeted on some equipment because of higher than normal dealer concessions and discounts which have offset expected price increases associated with increased manufacturing costs in the vehicles and related manufacturing industries. The trend has continued for most of 2008 purchases. However, vendors have indicated to us that due to increased prices associated with higher manufacturing costs, these concessions and discounts may no longer be available.
