- Webcams cannot produce a high quality video image as compared to a video conference unit.
- Webcams are designed to capture one or two persons whereas a video
  conference unit can capture up to a large conference room.
  - Webcams generally use the internet to connect to each other resulting in poor video quality and frequent interruptions whereas a video conference unit uses private networks to ensure high quality.
  - Generic software cannot provide a smooth video image to multiple locations at once.
  - Generic software cannot communicate with Hydro's existing video conferencing equipment.
- Generic software does not offer the security features that Hydro requires.
