

1 **B-6, New 25 kV Terminal Station, Labrador City, 2009 - \$283,200, 2010 -**
2 **\$3,894,800, Beyond - \$5,812,600**

3 Q. At what point and using what process does Newfoundland and Labrador
4 Hydro intend to procure the land necessary to build the proposed extension?

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7 A. New terminal stations are proposed at the sites of the existing Quartzite and
8 Vanier substations.

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10 An extension to the Quartzite substation site is required for the new proposed
11 25 kV terminal station. Hydro is currently in the process of arranging for the
12 purchase of the required land extension from the Town of Labrador City
13 (Labrador City). Pending approval, finalization of the purchase is expected
14 by early 2009.

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16 The land required for an extension to the Vanier substation is owned by the
17 Iron Ore Company of Canada (IOCC). Hydro and Labrador City have
18 contacted IOCC regarding the requirement for the extension. According to
19 Labrador City, IOCC has agreed to transfer ownership of the land to the town
20 which, in turn, has agreed to sell it to Hydro. Pending approval, transactions
21 are expected to be completed by early 2009.
