PUB - NLH – 27

Please provide a working electronic version of “Appendix A: RSP History – Activity and Balances,” as shown in the “Review of the Operation of the Rate Stabilization Plan, for the Period January 1, 2004 to December 31, 2005, a report dated June 30, 2006 and prepared per Board Order No. P.U. 14 (2004). Please provide the information requested in MS Excel format with formulas and all the supporting spreadsheets and files, preserving all links.

PUB – NLH – 28

In reference to Appendix A, please explain the adjustment column in detail and how the amounts therein have been calculated. This should be fully evident from the spreadsheet formulas, supporting spreadsheets and files.

PUB – NLH – 29

Please provide an update of Appendix A in MS Excel format for the years 2004 through 2009, with all supporting spreadsheets and files, with all links intact.

PUB – NLH – 30

For the years 2004 to 2009, provide a monthly detail of the Hydraulic production variation adjustment separating the amounts corresponding to Newfoundland Power, the rural retail customers and each of the Industrial Customers.

PUB – NLH – 31

For the years 2004 to 2009, provide a monthly detail of the Fuel variance adjustment, separating the amounts corresponding to Newfoundland Power, the rural retail customers and each of the Industrial Customers.

PUB – NLH – 32

For the years 2004 to 2009, provide a monthly detail of each of the components of the Load variation adjustment (fuel and revenue), separating the amounts corresponding to Newfoundland Power, the rural retail customers and each of the Industrial Customers.

PUB – NLH – 33

For the years 2004 to 2009, provide a monthly detail of the Rural Rate Alteration adjustment, separating the amounts corresponding to Newfoundland Power, the rural retail customers and each of the Industrial Customers.

PUB – NLH – 34

For the years 2004 to 2009, provide a monthly detail of the Financing adjustment, separating the amounts corresponding to Newfoundland Power, the rural retail customers and each of the Industrial Customers. Also, please provide detailed calculations showing how this adjustment is determined. This should be fully evident from the spreadsheet formulas, supporting spreadsheets and files.

PUB – NLH – 35

For the years 2004 to 2009, provide a monthly detail of any other adjustment (if any) incorporated in the updated Appendix A, separating the amounts corresponding to Newfoundland Power, the rural retail customers and each of the Industrial Customers. Also, please provide detailed calculations showing how these other adjustments are determined.

PUB – NLH – 36

For the years 2004 to 2009, provide a monthly detail of the Plan Balances, separating the amounts corresponding to Newfoundland Power, the rural retail customers and each of the Industrial Customers. Also, please provide detailed calculations showing how this breakdown is calculated. This should be fully evident from the spreadsheet formulas, supporting spreadsheets and files.

PUB – NLH – 37

Please provide a list of each of the RSP adjustment rates (current and historic) in place for each of the years from 2004 to 2009, indicating separately the rates that were applied to Newfoundland Power, rural retail customers, and each of the Industrial Customers. Also, please explain and show how each of the rates was determined and provide the calculation of these rates.

PUB – NLH – 38

Please provide a table showing the monthly amounts for each RSP component (hydraulic, fuel and load variation) that was collected/refunded each year during the period 2004 to 2009 through the adjustment rates, separating the amounts by Newfoundland Power, rural retail customers and each of the Industrial Customers.

PUB – NLH – 39

Some of the Plan Balances have been written off. Please specify the amount written off in each of the years from 2004 to 2009, and explain the reason for each write-off.
