- 6 Mr. P. Bowman is not necessarily proposing one or the other. In an appropriately structured
- 7 regulatory environment, where the utility is at risk for its own load, each option noted are tools
- 8 that a utility may use to try to address material changes in its circumstances, subject to
- 9 acceptability to the regulator.
- Where circumstances arise due to significant permanent changes to system load characteristics
- that drive changes in a utility's ability to recover its revenue requirement, base rates are properly
- 12 adjusted through a General Rate Application. In some circumstances it is possible that only
- 13 system loads and fuel volumes require adjustments; in those situations a limited scope
- rebalancing may be appropriate (such as contemplated in the IC rate design report).
