1 **QUESTION:**

- 2 (page 12, lines 18 21) In Mr. Bowman's opinion, what represents "reasonable rate change
- 3 bounds"?

4 **RESPONSE:**

- 5 Based on past practice in this jurisdiction, an RSP credit of 2 cents/kW.h to Industrial Customers
- 6 (equal to the RSP rate presently approved for Teck, as shown at Table 1 of Mr. P. Bowman's
- 7 evidence, at page 7) is clearly within the bounds of acceptable rate design. Mr. P. Bowman
- 8 would not recommend that negative rate riders materially in excess of this level be implemented.
- 9 If credit balances in the RSP exceed this level, other rebate measures should be investigated,
- such as longer amortization periods or one-time rebates.
