1 TOPIC: RSP OBJECTIVES

2 **QUESTION:**

- 3 Does Mr. Bowman believe that the use of Hydro's recommended cost of services approach or the
- 4 current RSP assignment approach in the load variation component is more likely to provide for
- 5 fair apportionment of costs (i.e., Board approved embedded costs) among customer classes?

6 **RESPONSE:**

- 7 Neither. Fair apportionment of costs is a matter addressed by the design of base rates at a GRA.
- 8 Outside of GRAs, the typical main consideration with respect to costs is not on changes in
- 9 embedded costs (related to "fair" rates), but rather reflecting marginal or incremental costs in
- 10 rate designs (related to "efficient" rates) so that customers see the incremental effect of their
- 11 consumption decisions. Rates remain fair to the extent they reflect approved costs at the last
- 12 GRA, and are adjusted for events that drive material changes in the utility's overall cost structure
- 13 (such as major load changes, which normally lead to a requirement for new GRA reviews).
