- Q. Re: Rocky Pond Plant Refurbishment (p. 2 of 81, Schedule B) - At page 6 of the 2 report entitled "Rocky Pond Hydro Plant Refurbishment" of June, 2008, reference 3 is made to the governor. Can the existing governor be reasonably expected to 4 operate properly for the foreseeable future? 5
- 6 A. No, it is not reasonable to expect that the existing governor will operate properly for the 7 foreseeable future.
- The governor is critical to the operation of the plant, and its deteriorated condition 9 requires its replacement in 2009. The existing governor is original to the plant's 1942 10 construction and has exceeded the expected normal life of this type of equipment.<sup>2</sup> 11

US Army Corp of Engineers indicates typical service life of governor control systems to be 15 to 40 years. The Rocky Pond governor control system is 66 years old.
