

Personal Computer Infrastructure (Pooled), p. 84 of 96, \$430,000

Q. In the 2009 Capital Budget Application the forecast number of computers for 2009 was 615 plus 25 laptops to be used in the Vehicle Mobile Computing Infrastructure, for a total of 640. Why has this number grown to 660 for 2009 in the current application?

A. The number of personal computers (“PCs”) forecast for 2009 has grown from 640 in the 2009 Capital Budget Application to 660 in the current application. This increase of 20 PCs relates to the following:

- 3 PCs were required for IS software development and testing purposes,
- 3 PCs were required in training/meeting rooms,
- 6 PCs were required for energy conservation, and
- 8 PCs were required in Operations to support distribution work flow.
