

1 **Q. Section 3.6.2. Application Costs of the Board and Consumer Advocate - the**  
2 **Company is proposing that these costs be recovered in 2010 customer rates on the**  
3 **basis (see footnote 110) that, “It is not currently expected that the rates set as a**  
4 **result of this Application will be in effect beyond 2010.” In the event that the rates**  
5 **set as a result of this Application are indeed in effect beyond 2010, how is the**  
6 **Company proposing to ensure that customers receive the benefit of the elimination**  
7 **of this expense after 2010?**

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9 A. Please refer to the response to Request for Information CA-NP-43 which is the  
10 Company’s five year financial forecast (the “financial forecast”). The financial forecast  
11 reflects the proposed recovery of the Application costs of the Board and Consumer  
12 Advocate in 2010.

14 It is currently forecast that in the years 2011 through 2013, Newfoundland Power will not  
15 recover all of its forecast costs.
