## Q. What does the \$100,000 litigation expense referred to at footnote 61 of p. 2-21 relate to? 3

A. The litigation expense refers to legal costs associated with the City of St. John's notice to terminate Newfoundland Power's lease of water rights in the Mobile River watershed.
Following a preliminary ruling by an arbitration panel established to determine the value of assets involved, the City of St. John's applied to the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador to have the ruling set aside. The City's application was heard in June 2009, and the matter is ongoing.
