## 1Q.Please describe NP's role in assisting its sister company Fortis Turks and Caicos in22008 in respect of hurricane damage and power outages in 2008.3

- A. In early September 2008, the Turks and Caicos Islands were struck by Tropical Storm
  Hanna, which was immediately followed by Hurricane Ike. Hurricane Ike was a
  Category 4 hurricane that caused major damage to the Fortis Turks and Caicos
  transmission and distribution system on South Caicos, with lesser damage occurring on
  North Caicos and Middle Caicos.
- Newfoundland Power, along with other Fortis Subsidiaries, sent a group of employees to
   assist Fortis Turks and Caicos with repairing its transmission and distribution system, and
   restoring electrical service. Newfoundland Power also coordinated the Fortis support to
   the Fortis Turks and Caicos hurricane relief effort.
- Newfoundland Power deployed a total of 17 staff to assist Fortis Turks and Caicos repair
  damage caused by Hurricane Ike in 2008. Staff were deployed from September 9 until
  October 31. The 3 electrical technologists were deployed for 2, 6, and 7 weeks
  respectively. The power line technicians were deployed in 2 shifts with 7 power line
  technicians in each 3 week shift.
