1	Q.	With regard to the reply to CA-NP-98, please fully explain how the initial forecast of
2		\$2,334,000 and the approved forecast \$1,623,000 for Temporary Labour was arrived
3		at.
4		
5		The overall reduction from the initial forecast of Temporary Labour costs reflects the
6		aggregate result of the budgetary process.
7		
8		The approved forecast for Temporary Labour includes the reclassification of 17
9		employees from temporary to regular status. Also included is an increase in Temporary
10		Labour relating to the operating portion of the labour of Apprentice Powerline
11		Technicians.
12		
13	1 1	The response to Request for Information CA-NP-99 illustrates a number of forecast
14		reductions related to labour costs.
15		
16		Newfoundland Power focuses on sustainable cost management. The changes between the
17		initial budgetary inputs and the approved forecast reflect the Company's actions to prudently manage costs.
