1 2 3	Q.	Further to CA-NP-150, please explain why NP seconded these personnel to other Fortis Inc. companies. Please also detail who carried out the functions of these personnel while on secondment.

5	A.	For Newfoundland Power, the principal benefit of a secondment arises from the career
6		development opportunity it provides for the seconded employee.
7		
8		Secondments expose employees to new work situations and, often, to different challenges
9		than their regular jobs. Seconded employees return to their regular employment with new
10		skills, knowledge and experience, which ultimately benefits both Newfoundland Power
11		and the individual employee.
12		
13		Due to the temporary nature of the transfers in question, Newfoundland Power was able
14		to absorb the duties of the seconded employees, in two of the four instances, by spreading
15		the work among the employee's co-workers. In the remaining two cases, other
16	1 2	employees were temporarily reassigned to cover the seconded employees'
17		responsibilities.
18		
19		The assumption of new responsibilities on a temporary basis resulting from a co-worker's
20		secondment provides other workers with an opportunity for broader work experience and
21		exposes them to new challenges. This contributes to their career development as well.
