6	A.	As stated in the Response to Request for Information PUB-NP-38, the proposed sale will
7		not have any impact on Newfoundland Power's lead role in restoration efforts when
8		power interruptions occur as a result of damage to Support Structures.
9		Newfoundland Power is obliged to deliver safe, reliable electricity service to its
10		customers. There are no provisions in either the Purchase Agreement or the 2011 Joint

Use Agreement that will alter Newfoundland Power's approach to restoration of

electricity service following the proposed sale.
