1	Q.	At page 7 of the 2001 Evidence it is stated that
2		
3		"It is not efficient for Aliant to continue to own the approximately 30,000 non-joint
4		use poles. Aliant would need to maintain a substantial amount of the
5		infrastructure and support services that it currently uses, but such infrastructure
6		would be applied to a vastly reduced and relatively small pole population."
7		
8		How many poles will Bell Aliant own if the 2011 Purchase Agreement is completed?
9		
0	A.	When the 2011 Purchase Agreement is completed it is estimated that Bell Aliant will own
1		approximately 93,000 Joint Use poles and 42,000 Non-Joint use poles in Newfoundland.
2		
3		These poles are in addition to the approximately 2.3 million poles that Bell Aliant
4		currently owns in Eastern Canada.
