- Q. In the report provided in Tab 2.3, pg. 1, footnote 2, NP makes reference to "sensitive locations". How are "sensitive locations" determined?
- 4 A. Sensitive locations are determined based on Section 16(1)(b)(i) of the federal *PCB*5 *Regulations* which came into force on September 5, 2008. The locations stated in these regulations are:
 - drinking water treatment plants;
 - food or feed processing plants;
 - child care facilities;
- preschools, primary schools or secondary schools;
- hospitals;

- senior citizens' care facilities; or
- on the property on which the plant or facility is located and within 100 metres of it.
