1	Q.	Reference Evidence of Newfoundland power, pages 4-15: Please confirm that the
2		fixed component of its non-energy costs has declined since 1991 according to Table
3		1? In the company's view does this indicate increasing or decreasing business risk?
4		
5	A.	Table 1 does not indicate that the fixed component of Newfoundland Power's non-energy
6		costs has declined as the question suggests.
7		
8		Please refer to the Evidence of Newfoundland Power, page 12, line 15 et. seq. where it is
9		stated that:
10		
11		"While reducing operating costs on a real basis is reflective of sound
12		management, the decreasing proportion of operating costs reduces the
13		Company's flexibility to respond to extraordinary operating events such as
14		those related to weather."
