3		Newfoundland Power is not inconsistent with Section 16 of Hydro's Rules and
4		Regulations, "Policies for Automatic Rate Changes", please explain why the
5		distribution of the Newfoundland Power RSP Surplus solely to Newfoundland Power
6		customers without a flow-through effect to customers on the L'Anse au Loup
7		System is inconsistent?

10	A.	The distribution of the Newfoundland Power RSP Surplus solely to Newfoundland
11		Power customers without a flow-through effect to customers on the L'Anse au Loup
12		System would not be consistent with Section 16 of Hydro's Rules and Regulations
13		which stipulates the effect on Rural Customers' rates upon a change in rates for NP

customers. Please also refer to Hydro's response to SR-NP-NLH-046. Charging

L'Anse au Loup System customers a lower effective rate by virtue of the Northern

Strategic Plan results in no further rate implications as only changes to NP's rates

are addressed in Section 16.

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
