1	Q.	Further to the responses to SR-PUB-NLH-008 and SR-PUB-NLH-012, explain in detail
2		how the refund to each Rural Customer will be calculated.
3		
4		
5	A.	The responses to SR-PUB-NLH-008 and SR-PUB-NLH-012 are based on Hydro's
6		recommended Proactive Approach as described in SR-NP-NLH-053. The specific
7		proposals stated in Hydro's Evidence on the RSP Surplus are:
8		
9		The RSP Surplus be refunded to Newfoundland Power customers on
10		their April 2014 electricity bills and be based on their total energy
11		consumption on bills issued during the period January 2013 to
12		December 2013.
13		<ul> <li>Hydro's Rural customers, whose rates are based on Newfoundland</li> </ul>
14		Power rates, will also receive a similar refund on their April 2014
15		electricity bills and which is based on their total energy consumption
16		on bills issued during the period January 2013 to December 2013.
17		• The refund to Rural customers will be funded from a portion of the
18		NP RSP surplus that is set aside for that purpose.
19		
20		The following formula details how the refund to each Hydro Rural Customer, as well
21		as each Newfoundland Power customer, is proposed to calculated:
