A. The project prioritization methodology is used to screen some of the projects under consideration for a given Capital Budget year. The prioritization process engages a wide range of Hydro personnel to determine which proposals should go forward. Previously, Hydro's upper and middle management would make the decision. Now, asset managers and other field personnel are active stakeholders in evaluating the projects through the use of the prioritization method. The method allows for a structural quantitative and qualitative approach to evaluate the importance and need for the proposal in the year under review.
