What is the current status of the proposed addition of the upgrade of the

3 transmission line corridor between Bay d'Espoir and Western Avalon?

A.

The proposed capital budget addition Upgrade Transmission Line Corridor – Bay d'Espoir to Western Avalon includes the addition of a new 230 kV transmission line between Bay d'Espoir and Western Avalon Terminal Stations. This system addition is required with the addition of the next major energy source for the Island whether that occurs in an isolated Island scenario or from a Labrador — Island transmission link. Nalcor's preferred energy source addition is the Lower Churchill Project Phase I, including the Muskrat Falls hydroelectric development and the Labrador — Island HVdc Transmission Link. The final project sanction decision is expected Fall 2012. Given that the expected in-service date of the Labrador — Island HVdc Transmission Link is 2017, Hydro has moved the Upgrade Transmission Line Corridor — Bay d'Espoir to Western Avalon proposal to coincide with the 2017 in-service date. As such, Hydro does not require capital funds for this project until 2014. Consequently a decision on this project will be required by the Board as part of Hydro's 2014 Capital Plan.
