Explain why 6 these proposed projects for the new diesel plants should be implemented prior to 7 an investigation into whether interconnection is a legitimate option, and given that 8 Hydro plans to submit a recommended solution by the end of March, 2013, 9 shouldn't these possibilities be explored first? 10 11 12 The above excerpt does not refer to any project proposal in the 2013 Capital Budget Α. 13 Application. Rather, it discusses supply alternatives for three isolated systems in the southern Labrador area. Construction of a larger regional plant accompanied by 14 15 an interconnection of Mary's Harbour, Port Hope Simpson, and Charlottetown is an 16 alternative to the three systems remaining isolated from one another. Hydro will make a recommendation for the least cost, safe and reliable alternative at the 17 18 appropriate time.
