4		conducting over the next several years" How many is Hydro planning to carry
5		out? Is it planning to do these itself or hire Hatch to do these?

8	A.	The long term plan for Hydro is to carry out risk assessments for all of its dykes and
9		dams. In keeping with Canadian Dam Association Guideline, all dams are required
10		to have a risk assessment conducted. There will be approximately 10 to 12 reservoi
11		risk assessments required to capture data on in excess of 80 dams and dykes.
12		Typically consultants will be utilized to undertake these risk assessments.
