- Q. (Re: Pre-filed Testimony of P. Bowman and H. Najmidinov, page 29, lines 31 to 34). It is stated "It is also clear that the existing high load factor industrial customers are being materially prejudiced by being included in a class with other customers who do not share like characteristics (most notably an equal Power on Order throughout the year)". Would it be more appropriate to treat Vale and Praxair as a separate class in the cost of service study? If not, why not?
- A. No. Please see Pre-filed Testimony of P. Bowman and H. Najmidinov, pages 27-29, noting that the "separate class" solution is modeled as part of IC-NLH-152 (discussed as page 27 line 8 to page 28 line 20) and further described as "Option 1" at page 29, which is dismissed as an inferior solution in the following discussion.
