

1 Q. (Rates and Regulation Evidence page 4.4, lines 3 to 4)

2 It is proposed that the NP rate recover 114% of costs derived in the 2013 cost of
3 service study including allocated rural deficit. If approved, what percentage of costs
4 will NP's domestic customers be paying considering the current revenue to cost
5 ratio established for this class by NP; i.e., 95%?
