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1	Q.	(GRA, Volume II, Exhibit 3 – Provincial Electrical Systems, page 3)
2		Are the consumption characteristics of Muskrat Falls similar to other customers on
3		the Labrador Interconnected System? Did Hydro consider making Muskrat Falls a
4		separate customer class?
5		
6		
7	A.	The Muskrat Falls Construction Project will be a year round customer with
8		electricity consumption characterized by space heating, water heating, lighting and
9		electric motor requirements, etc. These electricity consumption characteristics
10		would not be dissimilar to those of other customers with similar end-uses. The
11		annual maximum demand requirements for the Muskrat Falls customer are forecast
12		to be greater than 1000 kilovolt-amperes which will place the customer in rate class
13		No. 2.4L.
14		
15		Hydro did not consider making Muskrat Falls a separate customer class as it fell
16		within the criteria for rate class No. 2.4L, as stated above. Hydro's approved rules
17		and regulations do not contemplate separate rate classes under those
18		circumstances.
