14	A.	Please refer to CA-NLH-061 Attachment 1. This provides the rate on return on rate
15		base for the years 2005 to 2012. Please note that there was not an 'allowed range'
16		for rate of return on rate base prior to 2005 because this methodology was first
17		approved in Board Order P.U. No. 40(2004).
18		
19		Hydro has not exceeded the allowed range of return on rate base in any years from
20		2005 to 2012. In years that Hydro fell below the allowed range of return on rate
21		base the shortfall remained on the account of the shareholder and thus was not
22		addressed by the Board.
23		
24		The information requested regarding Newfoundland Power is not maintained by
25		Hydro.
