8		The increase in miscellaneous expenses from 2007 to 2014 forecast of \$2.2 million
9		(i.e., \$4.247 million to \$6.471 million) is primarily due to the following:
10		<ul> <li>An increase of \$1.1 million in CDM costs as a result of Hydro's</li> </ul>
11		implementation of its energy conservation program. However, CDM costs
12		are proposed to be deferred in cost recoveries;
13		<ul> <li>An increase of \$0.6 million in municipal taxes; and</li> </ul>
14		<ul> <li>An increase of \$0.3 million in payroll taxes due to an increase in total</li> </ul>
15		salaries.
16		
17		The increase in miscellaneous expenses from 2007 to 2015 forecast of \$1.5 million
18		(i.e., \$4.247 million to \$5.772 million) is primarily due to the following:
19		<ul> <li>An increase of \$0.7 million in municipal taxes;</li> </ul>
20		<ul> <li>An increase of \$0.4 million in payroll taxes due to an increase of total</li> </ul>
21		salaries; and
22		<ul> <li>An increase of \$0.2 million in CDM costs as a result of Hydro's</li> </ul>
23		implementation of its energy conservation program. However, CDM costs
24		are proposed to be defined in cost recoveries.
