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1	Q.	(Re: Response to CA-NLH-64) How would Lummus change its recommendations if
2		the RSP were abandoned?
3		
4		
5	A.	If the RSP were abandoned, Lummus Consultants would revise the energy
6		component of the rates for both NP and the IC. For NP this would involve the
7		consideration of moving return associated with customer costs and the rural deficit
3		into the first block. For the IC an inclining block energy rate would be considered
9		where the tail block is reflective of only fuel oil costs.
