1	Q.	(Re: Table 3.6 and CA-NLH-128) Please explain what makes up the material
2		components of the monthly Materials and Supplies amount.
3		
4		
5	A.	Materials and supplies of \$24,701 (Re: Table 3.6 and CA-NLH-128) include
6		consumables, inventory and critical spares that are used by Hydro operations for
7		construction and maintenance of operational assets and equipment.
8		
9		Consumables are low cost and non-critical supplies expected to turn over several
10		times during the fiscal year. For example, consumables include nuts, bolts, low
11		value hardware, gloves and safety glasses.
12		
13		Inventory items are expected to be used or consumed within one year and include
14		items such as poles, street lights, distribution transformers and pole line hardware.
15		
16		Critical spares are parts for a piece of equipment having long supplier lead times or
17		are not readily available. An example would be a three-phase recloser.
