1	Q.	Is the retirement allowance benefit of a term of employment of non-unionized
2		employees? If so, please provide the presently worded term of employment in
3		Hydro's employment contracts.

A. The provision and eligibility criteria for a retirement allowance benefit for non-union employees is the same as that provided to unionized employees and is part of Hydro's (Nalcor's) retirement benefit offering. Eligibility for a retirement allowance is dependent on meeting retirement eligibility criteria as outlined in Hydro's response to CA-NLH-239. The benefit, as defined in CA-NLH-239, is provided to all eligible employees. Hydro's employment offer letters generally provide a high level summary of the Company's compensation and benefit offering with references to how to find more information.
