1	Q.	In reply to PUB-NLH-302, Hydro states inter alia that the comparator group for Non-
2		Union Positions below Executive is the median of the Atlantic Canada Utilities. Why
3		does Hydro compare this group to Atlantic Canadian Utilities and not the broader
4		industry in Atlantic Canada or Canada?
5		
6		
7	A.	The majority of Hydro's workforce is in the utility business and therefore mostly
8		aligns with the utility industry. Hydro chooses to compare itself relative to the
9		Atlantic Canada Utilities, as this is where it competes for most employees below the
10		level of executive (in both union and non-union positions). The median represents
11		a competitive position that balances the need to attract quality candidates at
12		reasonable cost. CA-NLH-266, Attachment 1 provides an excerpt of Mercer's
13		compensation report which supports this as a reasonable, relevant market data
14		group.

16		Hydro does and will continue to review any market data deemed relevant based on
17		local influences and/or special skills.
