7		knowledge, the water rights held by CBPP are the same as have existed since the

knowledge, the water rights held by CBPP are the same as have existed since the time when its Deer Lake power plant was used both to provide power to its pulp and paper operations and as a power source to provide electricity to the residents and businesses in Corner Brook and the surrounding communities. In this sense, there appears to be no restrictions in CBPP's water rights as to selling power to third parties, including Hydro.
