1	Q.	Please confirm that the purpose of grouping "classes" in a cost of service study is to
2		avoid the need for calculating costs applicable to each individual customer, and to
3		instead focus on groups of customers with similar characteristics. If not confirmed,
4		please provide the rationale used by Hydro for developing its classes of customers.

7	A.	It is confirmed. Furthermore, the grouping of similar customers is required, since as
8		shown below, Section 73(1) of the Public Utilities Act requires that customers with
9		similar circumstances be charged the same rates.

11		Equality of rates

13		73. (1) All tolls, rates and charges shall always, under substantially similar
14		circumstances and conditions in respect of service of the same description,
15		be charged equally to all persons and at the same rate, and the board may
16		by regulation declare what shall constitute substantially similar
17		circumstances and conditions.
