1	Q.	Further to CA-NLH-295: Please provide dollar and percentage impacts to each
2		customer class based on the 2015 COS assuming the CBPP Frequency Converter is
3		assigned (a) 50% common and 50% specifically assigned, and (b) 100% as common.

6	A.	CBPP specifically assigned charges would change from the \$891,045 proposed in
7		Hydro's Amended Application to \$364,711 with a 50% assignment to common and
8		to \$0 with 100% of the frequency converter assets assigned to common.
9		
10		The reduced specifically assigned charges under both scenarios would increase
11		common costs, of which approximately 90% would be recovered from
12		Newfoundland Power.
