3		Please explain how the modifications in the Newfoundland Power (NP) utility rate
4		proposed in the present application will be reflected in NF Power's rates, given that
5		NP's 2013-14 General Rate Review has already fixed rates based on power supply
6		costs for 2013 and 2014 based on current rates.

9	A.	The typical process of establishing NP related rates is:
10		 Hydro receives Board approval of its rates to NP;
11		NP completes its rate design and applies for Board approval of its resultant
12		rates (often referred to as a flow-through application):
13		Hydro applies NP's rate design results to its relevant rural customers and
14		applies for Board approval of its resultant rates.
15		These applications are independent of the results of NP's own GRA or other rate
16		applications.
