Q. 1 Re: NLH Evidence, Section 4, page 4.26, lines 7-9. It is stated, "The diesel unit cost variation will be allocated between NP and 2 3 Labrador Interconnected Rural Customers in the same proportion as the rural 4 deficit was allocated in the approved Test Year Cost of Service Study." Please summarize the calculation and allocation of the rural deficit, providing 5 6 specific references to the cost of service study. 7 8 9 A. The detailed calculation and allocation of the rural deficit is shown in Exhibit 13, Schedule 1.2, Page 1. The total rural deficit is \$64,070,303 (Line 14, Column 5), of 10 which \$2,408,108 (Line 8, column 5), or 3.76% is allocated to the Labrador 11 Interconnected System. This amount is based on Hydro's proposed Rural Deficit 12 13 Allocation methodology described in Section 4.3.1 of Hydro's Amended Application.
