The application of the RSP has no effect on Labrador Interconnected customers. It 8 does, however, impact Labrador Isolated customers. The annual July 1 RSP 9 Adjustment applied to NP, and in turn its customers, automatically flows through to 10 the majority of Hydro's rural customers. Please refer to Section 16 "Policies for Automatic Rate Changes" of the Rate Schedules filed as part of the evidence. 11 12 13 It is anticipated that the disposition of the RSP Surplus will impact Hydro customers 14 whose rates are based on NP rates, including Labrador Isolated, in the form of a 15 refund and not an electricity rate adjustment (per Order in Council (OC) OC2013-16 089 dated April 4, 2013, as amended by OC2013-207 dated July 16, 2013). A final 17 decision on the disposition of the RSP Surplus is within the jurisdiction of the Board.
